*Visiting:* Monuments and places belonging to Sousa Valley (Penafiel, Paredes, Felgueiras, Lousada, Paços de Ferreira and Castelo de Paiva)

### *Program:*

- 1º Dia* Visit the Monastery of Santa Maria de Pombeiro in Felgueiras with a brief explanation of the Portuguese pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela  
A taste of local pastries Pão-de-ló de Margaride and cavacas  
Visit to the Church of Saint Vincent of Sousa  
Regional lunch in a local restaurant  
Visit to the Church of Saint Mammes of Vila Verde with an explanation of his location at the romaneseque period  
Visit to the Tower of Vilar  
Visit to the Casa de Juste and its beautiful gardens, followed by a '5 o'clock tea'  
Dinner and accommodation at a 4\*hotel
- 2º Dia* Visit to the beautiful and unique gardens of Quinta da Aveleda, with a wine and cheese taste  
Free time at Penafiel city  
Regional lunch in a local restaurant  
Visit to the Monastery of Saint Peter of Cête  
Visit to the Monastery of Saint Peter of Ferreira, one of the most singular monuments of the Portuguese Romanesque, which retains its narthex  
Visit to a green wine lodge followed by a wine tasting  
Dinner and accommodation at a 4\*hotel
- 3º Dia* Check-out of the hotel  
Visit the Church of Saint Genes of Boelhe, described as the most little church of the Iberia Peninsula  
Visit and interpretation of the Church of Saint Peter of Abrugão  
In Castelo de Paiva, we can admire the beautiful views of the Douro and Tâmega, as also the Memorial of Sobrado  
Regional lunch in a local restaurant  
Visit the Monastery of the Saviour of Paço de Sousa with an explanation of Egas Moniz Tomb  
Memorial of Hermitage Memorial  
Return to the hotel
